And Resolved:-

That this Board of Management of Sharon Church, a body corporate under the laws of Nova Scotia, do now resign in a body, for the purpose of giving the Annual Meeting of the Congregation of Sharon and St. John United, of which Congregation Sharon is now a part, an opportunity of appointing a Board of Trustees which shall hold in trust all property, formerly held in trust by the two congregations of Sharon and St. John, ~~United~~, congregations belonging to the United Church of Canada. Such property to be held and administered for the benefit of the Congregation of Sharon and St. John, United, as a part of the United Church of Canada, upon the terms and provisions set forth in the Act incorporating the United Church of Canada.
