Know all men by these Presents,
that we John McQuarrie, Daniel Cameron,
William Sutherland and James McDonald
all of Stellarton in the County of Pictou and
Province of Nova Scotia: "Trustees" of St John's
Church in connection with the Church of Scotland
and our successors in office, for and in behalf of
the congregation of the said Church, do hold and
connection in connection with the Church of Scotland
aforesaid in the sum of Eight Hundred dollars (\$800⁰⁰)
lawful money of Canada to be paid to the Rev Edward
B. Rankin minister of the Gospel in con-
nection with the said church his Executors and
Administrators and assigns, yearly, commencing
with and being due one year after his the said Rev Edward
B Rankin's induction as Minister of the said
congregation by the said Presbytery, thereafter to be
paid each consecutive year, so long as he the said
Rev. Edward B Rankine shall continue to be
Minister of the said Congregation, together with the free
tenantry of the Glebe and Manse, of the said Congregation,
with all the rights and privileges thereto annexed
for which payments well and truly to be made.
We and our successors in office and each of us
are firmly bound by these presents, The Condition
of the above obligation is such that if the said
John McQuarrie, Daniel Cameron, William Sutherland
and James McDonald and their successors in
office shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
the above named Rev. Edward B. Rankin his Executors

Administrators or assigns the consideration therein
mentioned, as therein stipulated, then the above obligation to be
void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
