the said church, his executors, Adminis-
-trators and assigns, yearly, commencing
with and being due one year after his
the said Rev. Edwin H. Burgess's induc-
-tion as Minister of the said Congregation
by the said Presbytery, thereafter to be
paid each consecutive year, so long as
he the said Rev. Edwin H. Burgess shall
continue to be minister of the said Con-
-gregation, together with, the free tenantry
of the Glebe and Manse, of the said
Congregation, with all the rights and
privileges thereto connected, for which pay-
-ments well and truly to be made. We
and our successors in office and each
of us are firmly bound by these presents,
