Your letter is received, and I appreciate very much the fact that you have written to me about the trouble you are having with accoustic in the Sharon United Church, Stellarton, N.S.

I do not know where you could procure the wires to cut the vibrations as I do not know a firm ~~now~~ who is doing that kind of business now.

I do know that the system of installing wires is not always a good one, and I have always ~~doubted~~ *doubted* same to be satisfactory.

There has been a lot of experiments made in the last few years with "CELOTEX" Paper, and other materiel of the same product, and in most case it has been very satisfactory.

In some churches and halls they have putted large panels of "CELOTEX" some time on the side and back walls and some time on the ceelings, and have improved the accoustic considerably, and ~~not~~ almost satisfactory.

You could write to the "CELOTEX" firm, in Mon-tréal or Toronto, and they would supply with valuable informa-tion free of cost. But I would suggest that you see your architect, and plans could be proposed to the "CELOTEX" people and they would direct you the right way I am sure.
