Know all men by these Presents; That we John McQuarrie -  
Daniel Cameron and Alexander Stewart all of Stellarton  
in the County of Pictou in the Province of Nova Scotia, Trustees of  
S<sup>t</sup> Johns Church in connection with the church of Scotland and our  
Successors in Office for and in behalf of the congregation of the  
said Church, are lawfully bound unto the Presbytery  
of Egerton in connection with the church of Scotland aforesaid in  
the sum of seven hundred dollars (\$700<sup>00</sup>) lawful money  
of Canada to be paid to the Rev James Murray minister of the  
Gospel in connection with the said church his Executors - Admin-  
-istrators and assigns, yearly, commencing with and being due one  
year after his the said Rev James Murray's induction as minister of  
the said Congregation by the said Presbytery hereafter to be paid each con-  
-tinuous year, so long as he the said Rev James Murray shall continue to be  
minister of the said Congregation together with the free tenantry of the  
Glebe and Manse of the said Congregation with all the rights and  
privileges thereto connected, for which payments well and truly to  
be made. We and our successors in office and each of us are  
firmly bound by these presents. The condition of the above obligation  
is such that if the said John McQuarrie - Daniel Cameron  
and

Alexander Stewart and their successors in office shall well  
and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named  
Rev James Murray his executors, administrators or assigns the  
consideration therein mentioned, as therein stipulated, but  
the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force  
and virtue
