The Board of Trustees of Sharon St. John United Church held four official meetings and several committee and informal meetings during the past year.

Several attempts were made to dispose of the St. John Church and although no formal announcement can be made at this date, it is expected that by next week final arrangements will be completed to sell this property.

The St. John Church Bell was sold for the sum of \$100.00.

One of the Hot Air Furnaces of the St. John Church was sold for \$40.00.

The mortgage payments on the St. John Manse were paid in full.

Only minor repairs were required to be made on Wesley Hall, this building is in good repair.

No repairs were needed on the Manse property, but this building has still to receive a second coat of paint which should be made in 1937.

The Board of Stewarts are to be commended on the fine work accomplished in the redecorating of the Church Auditorium, the Church now presents a very attractive appearance. Some repairs to the plaster of one of the Hall rooms was done, this being the only maintenance work required\_/ of the Trustees.

It is recommended that consideration be given to the redecorating of the Church Hall, the adjoining rooms and stairways, this work is urgent, as the walls badly discolored and unsightly. It will also be necessary to re-putty the windows on the North side of the Church and practically all of the outside woodwork requires painting. The cement blocks in front of the Church should be repaired.

The Trustees have in the Bank the sum of \$407.15, which funds can be made available for some of the work suggested.
